Abstract:

Traditionally, settlement information is managed by Excel spreadsheet, supplemented with CAD drawings. Correlation of settlements to the construction work could be a time consuming and inefficient process... not to mention carrying out spatial analysis or sharing of the information to the management in a timely manner.

With the aid of the latest web GIS technology, Spatial Technology has developed and deployed a deformation management portal solution in several major engineering site offices. Surveyors and Engineers can hence access settlement data, reports, graphs, maps, generate inference zone, etc simply through Internet Explorer via internal network, based on different levels of access rights. Enhanced project efficiency and faster decision-making process can then be facilitated through instant data sharing and reporting.

In the session, Andy Chan would like to share his recent experience in the implementation of these systems, describing the system architecture based on Autodesk Mapguide Enterprise, introducing its unique features as well as highlighting how the engineers can benefit from this solution
