Abstract:

Laser Scanner had been used in the project of Harbour Area Treatment Scheme (HATS) Stage 2A. This project includes the construction of eight vertical shafts and three deep tunnels using drill and blast techniques, where the tunnels are totaling 12km in length and the shafts at 165m below ground.

The laser scanner had been used to survey the as-built record of shafts and tunnels, the results were used to compare with the theoretical profiles, to calculate the underbreak and overbreak areas during excavation. In this talk, the as-built profiles of shafts and tunnels using laser scanner and data processing by TMS Office will be described. There will be a discussion of the pros and cons of using laser scanner and TMS Office.
