Event Overview:

The RICS Hong Kong Geomatics Professional Group Committee is organising a CPD event, titled: 'Urban Land Boundary Survey in Hong Kong'. The event will introduce the land boundary survey in Hong Kong and the differences in conducting surveys in the urban areas and the New Territories.

In Hong Kong, land suitable for development is scarce especially in urban areas on the Hong Kong Island and Kowloon. It is densely populated – about 48% of the population lives in only 12% of land in Hong Kong. Due to the scarcity of land supply, land is the valuable goods and its extent is mainly defined by the land boundary.

The Survey and Mapping Office (SMO) of the Lands Department is the vital administration of the HKSAR Government which deals with the land boundary in Hong Kong. SMO is formed by ten District Survey Offices (DSOs). Two offices oversee the urban areas and eight of them cover the New Territories (NT) areas. The land boundary survey in the urban and NT DSOs are generally referred to as urban and NT land boundary surveys respectively. Apart from their geographical difference, they have different requirements on staffing – staff members are expected to possess specific knowledge and skill sets for their particular area of work. The speaker will explain the differences in these two areas of survey in the seminar.
