Abstract:

According to the figures from Office of the Government Chief Information Officer, Hong Kong mobile penetration rate of over 238% (as at December 2013) is among the highest in the world. Number of mobile users capable of gaining access to mobile data services (2.5G/3G/4G) stands at 12.1 million in December 2013, with mobile data usage amounting to 997Megabytes per user.

Meanwhile, the demand in mobile mapping solution is increasing continuously. We are pleased to invite Prof. Ryan Ge who is an expert on mobile mapping to introduce the development in MMS.

In this CPD, Ryan will introduce the background and components of the MMS systems. After that, Ryan will show us the latest MMS applications and he will share the trail results of the PanoMMS Backpack system in Hong Kong.
