記雲南技術交流團 (林烈賢)

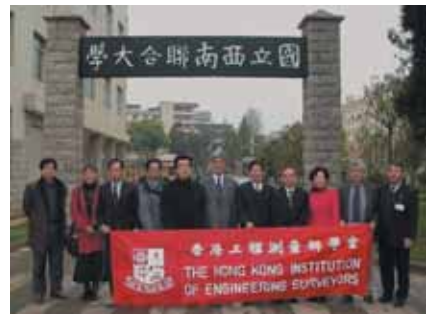
香港工程測量師學會(HKIES)及英國土木工程測量師學會(香港分會)(ICES-HK Region)一行十九人組成代表團，於2005年3月24日至29日聯合訪問雲南省作技術交流及觀光。

代表團分別探訪了昆明冶金專科學校、雲南省師範大學、雲南有色勘察設計院、雲南省測繪學會等多個雲南省廳級機構，了解到該省於測繪科技方面最新的發展情況。認識到雲南省當局於栽培及訓練測繪人才上，確實是投放了相當大的資源及心血，加上政府相應的政策及規劃，代表團深信該省各測繪單位及人才，對於未來雲南省以至中國西部一帶的發展上，將會擔當更重要的位置。

代表團更於3月25日獲中國人民政治協商會議雲南省委員會 管國忠副主席接見。會面期間，管副主席對代表團於促進兩地測繪技術交流方面的貢獻予以積極及正面的評價。

代表團其後更有機會走訪大理及麗江兩地多處名勝地方，親身體會當地近年之發展情況。

在這六天的訪問行程中，承蒙雲南省科協科技諮詢中心理事徐繼忠先生悉心安排行程，與及雲南省測繪局、雲南省測繪學會等各廳級及處級機構負責人的熱情招待，令代表團各人對於昆明人熱情好客的一面，留下深刻印象。



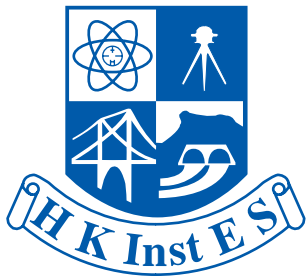
管國忠會見香港客人

Past Events (LAM Lit-yin)

On 26 January 2005, 46 members and guests attended the CPD talk "Hydrographic Surveying and Mapping Techniques for Coastal Construction Projects" presented by Mr. Steve Lam, Lecturer, Department of LSGI, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, at MTRC Auditorium. In this event, Mr. Steve Lam presented: (a) principal elements of the automated hydrographic system for coastal construction projects; and (b) the application of Delaunay Triangulated Model to eliminate tide-gauge measurements and to achieve more accurate result in processing the bathymetric data.



Technical Site Visit to Route 8 --- Ngong Shuen Chau Viaduct



15 members visited the Phase 1 of the project "Ngong Shuen Chau Viaduct (NSCV)" on 12 March 2005. The project is a part of the Route 8, a strategic link between North West Tsing Yi and West Kowloon and comprises three major elements --- Nam Wan Tunnel and approach viaducts, Stonecutters bridge (SCB and Ngong Shuen Chau Viaduct (NSCV). The NSCV is a dual 3-lane expressway by specially using the Precast Segmental Balanced Cantilever Method. The site representatives have presented a brief introduction of the project, and other technical issues including Geometry Control, Bored Pile Construction and Segment Erection.
