There were about 110 participants joined the CPD function, "Construction Information Modeling (CIM) for Surveyors" presented by Mr. Kenny Tse of PolyU and Mr. Andy Chan of Spatial Technology Ltd/ Autodesk Far East Ltd. at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University on 30-Aug-2007. The speakers shared their experience in deployment of the CIM in a Secondary School development project and in the Eagle Nest Tunnel project. How taking-off could be done accurately and effectively by using 3D Software was shown.

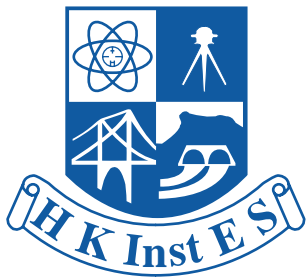
Happy 70th Anniversary to The Hong Kong Polytechnic University

隨著澳門的工程項目數量日漸增多，種類亦趨複雜，對於當地工程測量技術的要求更是越見嚴謹。有見及此，澳門地理測繪學會於7月21日假座澳門港務局航海學校演講廳，舉辦了一次名為“工程測繪技術經驗交流會”的講座，邀請三位來自香港工程測量師學會的代表，與澳門同業分享經驗及心得。

當日會長梁振慶先生主講“測量放點的質量保證”，提到質量保證於工程項目的重要性，與及當中對工程測量人員的要求及挑戰；他亦分享了一些有關測量放點的技巧與心得。接著主席李鴻盛先生的講題為“工程測量師在大型鐵路建設項目監督中的責任”，其中提到有關工程測量師於鐵路建設項目中要注意的事項及細節、技術的要求、管理的經驗，皆是將來澳門興建捷運鐵路的重要借鑑。最後“當代測量師的角色；工程與建築中雷射掃瞄器的應用”是副主席黃伯偉先生的分享題目，他用生動的例子，分析了當今建築工程業界的最新發展、香港及澳門兩地對工程測量師要求的異同等；他更引用雷射掃瞄技術作例子，讓與會者更深切明白到工程測量師可怎樣利用最新的測量技術，來提高工作效率及質素。

是次交流會在嚴肅但輕鬆的氣氛下結束，主辦者及參與者皆期望將來有更多類似的活動，讓兩地工程測量專業有更長足的進步。
